lake louise summer camp & retreat policies

I understand that any of the following circumstances could, in the reasonable discretion of the Lake Louise Executive Director, require me to return home.

A. The violation of any of the Lake Louise Summer Camp & Retreat ground rules which include:

1. Alcohol or narcotics/drugs (including cigarettes) of any sort are forbidden on Lake Louise Summer Camp grounds or program sites.
2. Sexual behavior or excessive displays of affections that detract from group participation is neither acceptable nor permitted.
3. Permission is required from the Lake Louise Executive Director to leave the group or defined boundaries at any time.
4. Inappropriate social behavior is not acceptable because it effects Lake Louise Summer Camp's ability to conduct a safe and effect program.

B. Commission of a crime, am arrested, or the use and/or possession a weapon.

C. Any illness or injury that would make their continuing on with camp ill advised.

D. The following items are banned by Lake Louise Summer Camp: All controlled substances, personal sporting equipment, weapons, and animals.

I understand and agree to the above ground rules. Violation of these ground rules may result in me being sent home at my expense.

Lake Louise Camp reserves the right to perform a search of a volunteer's property in the event of suspected illegal substances or weapons.

Lake Louise Camp is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Signature grants permission for name, address, email address, and telephone number to be released to other volunteers. Signature also acknowledges that the individual attending camp will participate in outdoor activities and he/she participates at his/her own risk.

PAPERWORK REQUIRED

I understand Lake Louise requires the following paperwork and documentation to be completed and **received** by the office by June 1st.

- Volunteer Registration Form (2 pages - Please remember to sign both pages.)
- Personal Information & Criminal Records Check Authorization Form
- Lake Louise Child Protection Certification Application
- Lake Louise Church and Volunteer History Form
- Three references
- Central Registry Clearance (It is your responsibility to submit this form. If you live out of state it is your responsibility to submit to the state equivalent and have results sent to Lake Louise so they are on file at least 1 month prior to date service commences.)
- Driver's license (legible copy)
- Medical/first responder license (copy)
- Adult Health History Form

I understand if these documents are not on file, I may not be able to serve on the volunteer staff.

Final determinations as to whether or not volunteers may serve at camp are made solely by the Lake Louise executive director and program development & marketing director.

If I arrive at camp without proper documentation and am not allowed to serve, I understand all travel expenses incurred are my responsibility, and Lake Louise is not responsible for reimbursement for lost wages or vacation at my place of employment.
